Earthquake hits Tokyo region, scores injured

A magnitude 5.9 earthquake struck eastern Japan early on August 23, injuring more than 40 people in Tokyo and neighbouring prefectures and prompting the Japan Meteorological Agency to warn of further strong shaking in the coming days.

According to *Kyodo News*, the earthquake struck at about 2am, with its epicentre in southern Ibaraki prefecture to the northeast of the capital at a depth of 68km, the weather agency said. No tsunami was generated.

The quake registered lower 5 on Japan's seven-point seismic intensity scale in parts of Ibaraki as well as central Tokyo. The level is considered strong enough to frighten most people and cause them to hold on to stable objects, while items can fall from shelves.

Spain earthquakes mapped: More than 600 evacuated after quake

At least 600 people have been evacuated from their homes after a series of relentless earthquakes hit Granada on Tuesday, triggering safety cordons and forcing residents into temporary public shelters.

Authorities ordered the urgent evacuation of six apartment blocks — holding 371 homes — in Las Gabias, southwestern Granada, after deep structural cracks appeared in building walls following dozens of tremors throughout the day. Andalucian emergency services minister Antonio Sanz confirmed that the mass movement of residents was ordered as a precautionary measure, noting that none of the residential structures appeared to be in immediate danger of collapse.

Speaking to reporters, Mr Sanz said: "The situation will now be evaluated, but there is no imminent danger.

7.7-magnitude earthquake hits Indonesia

The initial earthquake struck Indonesia's Flores region 42 miles northwest of Ende. The epicenters of all the quakes occurred in the Flores Sea.

Ukraine Blitzes Russia's Black Sea Naval Stronghold

Ukrainian anti-ship missiles, jet-powered aerial drones and sea drones blitzed a major Russian naval base on the Black Sea coast in a “unique” nighttime operation, Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy said Wednesday.

Cutting-edge drones developed by Kyiv since Russia invaded more than four years ago have repeatedly targeted Russian ships in the Black Sea, including warships and oil tankers. Both countries have Black Sea shorelines.

officials say, in one of the country's biggest accomplishments of the war.

7.4 Earthquake Shakes Colombia and Ecuador, Prompting People to Evacuate Buildings

A powerful 7.4-magnitude earthquake struck western Colombia on Monday, shaking the South American nation and neighboring Ecuador and prompting people to evacuate homes and buildings. The epicenter was in San Jose Del Palmar, a municipality in the Choco region about 250 miles (400 kilometers) west of Colombia's capital, Bogota, the U.S. Geological Survey and Colombia's counterpart reported. The USGS said it struck at a depth of 66 miles (107 kilometers).

A powerful magnitude 7.4 earthquake struck off the coast of Mexico's southern state of Chiapas, triggering a tsunami warning.

The quake, which struck near the Mexican city of Puerto Madero, was at a shallow depth of 10 km, the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) said. Witnesses said it shook buildings in neighbouring Guatemala.

Following the tremor, the US Tsunami Warning System issued a tsunami threat for the region.

The tremor was also felt in El Salvador, another Reuters witness said.

2 NATO Countries Warn Russia Preparing for Attack, Escalation

Japan: 7.2 magnitude earthquake hits northeastern region, injuring at least 10 people

4:50 PM – Thursday, June 25, 2026

An earthquake struck Japan's northeastern coast on Thursday, injuring at least ten people in northern prefectures of Aomori and Iwate, Japanese authorities reported.

The U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) initially measured it as a 6.9 magnitude, and the Japan Meteorological Agency (JMA) similarly called it a 6.9 before upgrading their tracking to a 7.2 magnitude. Additionally, some Japanese outlets have since reported that approximately 11 people have been injured as a result.

Fortunately, no life-threatening injuries or deaths have been reported.

Striking at 7:30 a.m. local time on Thursday, the quake shook dozens of towns across northeastern Japan and triggered mild tremors as far away as Tokyo. The hardest-hit area was Aomori Prefecture, which registered an "upper 6" on Japan's 7-point seismic intensity scale — a level of shaking so severe it makes standing or walking impossible.

6:36 AM – Thursday, June 25, 2026

Two massive back-to-back earthquakes rocked Venezuela, with reports of collapsed buildings and high casualties.

Per media reports, Venezuelan acting President Delcy Rodríguez provided an update on Thursday morning that at least 164 people died and nearly 1,000 were injured. She had

previously noted that the state of La Guaira, north of the capital city of Caracas, on the coast, was reported as the worst hit, with dozens of collapsed buildings. The foreshock, a 7.2 magnitude earthquake, occurred at 6:04 p.m. local time on Wednesday, originating in the north of the country, and was followed just 39 seconds later by the mainshock of 7.5, according to the United States Geological Survey (USGS). Its early estimate put the single most likely statistical outcome of the quakes causing at least 10,000 deaths, at 42%. It also predicted heavy economic losses for the country, ranging from between 1% to 7% of Venezuela's gross domestic product (GDP).

Study: Global Conflicts Reached 80-Year High in '25

The number of armed conflicts worldwide reached its highest level since World War II last year, while conflict-related deaths climbed to their deadliest levels in more than three decades, according to a [new study](#) by researchers at Sweden's Uppsala University.

Researchers with the Uppsala Conflict Data Program, widely regarded as one of the world's leading trackers of armed violence, recorded 65 active conflicts last year, according to [KPBS](#).

The study found that direct conflicts between states doubled from the previous year to eight, the highest number since the organization began collecting data in 1946.

Massive 7.8 magnitude Philippines earthquake kills 32 and sparks terrifying tsunami

A massive 7.8 earthquake struck Mindanao in the southern Philippines leaving at 32 people dead and a terrifying tsunami.

The tremor also injured more than 200 others mostly in damaged buildings before sending a 1-meter (3-foot) tsunami into nearby coasts. The [quake](#) struck around 11:38 p.m. UTC Sunday, prompting the Pacific Tsunami Warning Center to issue [the warning for several countries](#) across the western Pacific. According to the PTWC, hazardous tsunami waves are possible and could affect parts of the Philippines, Indonesia, Palau, Yap, Taiwan, and Papua New Guinea within the next 3 hours.

According to the agency, the earliest projected arrivals are in coastal areas near the earthquake zone in the southern Philippines and eastern Indonesia, shortly after midnight UTC. Reports say that Davao, the largest city in the Philippines, could see the [first wave as early as 12:08 a.m.](#)

Earthquake cluster rattles West Coast near mega-tsunami danger zone

Three earthquakes rattled the U.S. West Coast on Wednesday, serving as another reminder that one of North America's most dangerous seismic zones lies just offshore.

The strongest of the trio struck off the southern Oregon coast, where the [U.S. Geological Survey reported a magnitude-5.7 earthquake approximately 100 miles west of Pistol River](#). The quake occurred at a depth of roughly 10 kilometers (6 miles) within the offshore Blanco Fracture Zone, a geologically active area where several tectonic plates interact. According to the USGS and the National Tsunami Warning Center, no tsunami threat was generated by the event.

The Oregon quake was accompanied by two additional earthquakes elsewhere along the West Coast on the same day. While none caused significant damage or injuries, the cluster attracted attention because of its proximity to one of the most closely watched seismic regions in North America, let alone the entire world.

Magnitude 6.2 earthquake shakes southern Italy

A strong earthquake tremor was felt across much of southern Italy shortly after midnight on 2 June.

[The National Institute of Geophysics and Volcanology \(INGV\) recorded a magnitude 6.2 earthquake](#) with its epicentre out at sea off Calabria's Tyrrhenian coast, near Belmonte Calabro, in the province of Cosenza. The quake struck at a depth of 250 kilometres.

The tremor was strongly felt along the Tyrrhenian coast, but no damage has been reported so far. The earthquake was also felt in Naples and the Vesuvius area, as well as in several parts of Calabria, Basilicata, Puglia and Sicily.

A magnitude 5.4 earthquake struck the Tongan Trench on June 3, 2026, shaking the seafloor roughly 180 kilometers northeast of Neiafu, the main town in

Tonga's Vava'u island group. According to the [U.S. Geological Survey's real-time earthquake feed](#), the quake ranked among the strongest seismic events recorded anywhere in the South Pacific over the preceding 24 hours.

A magnitude 4.5 earthquake rattled the coast near Manokwari, a city of roughly 190,000 on the Bird's Head Peninsula in Indonesia's Papua region, during the last week of May 2026. According to the [USGS event page for this earthquake](#), the quake struck at a depth of approximately 10 kilometers at 03:42 UTC, placing the rupture squarely in the upper crust and concentrating energy close to the surface. That shallow origin likely produced sharp, distinct shaking for residents closest to the epicenter. No reports of significant damage or injuries have surfaced, but the event adds to a busy stretch of seismic activity along the Pacific Ring of Fire that has kept communities across the western Pacific on edge
