China Testing 'Robot Wolves' in High-Tech Assault Drills for Taiwan Invasion

China is testing a new wave of high-tech assault robots in preparation for potential amphibious operations against Taiwan, unveiling "robot wolves" designed to spearhead beach landings that military planners say would be among the most difficult missions in modern warfare.

Video released on state television shows militarized versions of four-legged "robot dogs," previously used for search-and-rescue work, now repurposed to storm fortified shoreline positions ahead of human troops, reports <u>The Times</u> on Thursday.

The robots, controlled from units mounted on army transports and operating at ranges of about 1.2 miles, rapidly cut through barbed wire and other obstacles during recent beach exercises.

November 12, 2025 Two earthquakes in Cyprus felt in northern Israel

Two earthquakes measuring 5.2 and 5.3 hit Cyprus, are felt in northern Israel.

No injuries or property damage were reported.

According to data from the European-Mediterranean Seismological Centre (EMSC), the earthquake measured 5.2 on the Richter scale and occurred at a depth of 24 kilometers below the Earth's surface.

According to EMSC, the epicenter of the second quake, measured at 5.3 on the Richter scale, was also in Cyprus, 3 km SE of Meládeia, at a depth of 10.0 km.

Powerful 6.3 quake kills at least 20 in Afghanistan, hundreds injured

KABUL, Nov 3 (Reuters) - A powerful 6.3 magnitude earthquake struck near the northern Afghan city of Mazar-e Sharif early on Monday, killing at least 20 people, injuring hundreds and damaging the city's historic Blue Mosque, authorities said, with the death toll likely to rise.

The U.S. Geological Survey said the quake hit at a depth of 28 km (17.4 miles) near Mazar-e Sharif, a city of around 523,000 people famous for its shrines and historic sites.

Two earthquakes struck off the Oregon coast on Tuesday, rattling communities along the Pacific Northwest shoreline.

The first temblor registered a magnitude of 5.4 and occurred about 100 miles west of Port Orford, according to the United States Geological Survey (USGS). A second tremor followed hours later, measuring magnitude 4.8, as part of a continuing offshore sequence.

The announcement, which followed years of tests of the Burevestnik missile, comes as part of nuclear messaging from the Kremlin, which has resisted Western pressure for a ceasefire in Ukraine and strongly warned the U.S. and other NATO allies against sanctioning strikes deep inside Russia with longer-range Western weapons. Taal Volcano Erupts in the Philippines, Blasting Ash Over a Mile High

Late last night, Taal Volcano, one of the most active in the Philippines, erupted, sending a dense column of ash and steam more than a mile high above Batangas province. The eruption was short but intense, marked by multiple phreatomagmatic bursts and low-frequency tremors. The Philippine Institute of Volcanology and Seismology (PHIVOLCS) confirmed that the activity was centered within the Main Crater and warned residents to stay cautious as sulfuric gases and fine ash spread to nearby towns. While the alert level remains low, scientists say the event highlights how quickly Taal can shift from calm to dangerous.

An Iranian Volcano Appears to Have Woken Up 700,000 Years After Its Last Eruption

For centuries, the Taftan volcano in southeastern Iran was considered inactive; just another mountain in the desert. But recent evidence shows that something beneath it has started to shift.

Between July 2023 and May 2024, the ground near Taftan's summit rose by roughly 9 centimeters, according to a new study published in <u>Geophysical</u> <u>Research Letters</u>. The finding marks the first clear sign of unrest at a volcano that last erupted about 700,000 years ago.
