1 Dead After 6.3 Earthquake Rocks China's Qinghai

A magnitude 6.3 earthquake hit the northwestern Chinese province of Qinghai on Tuesday, killing at least one person and injuring four, as rescuers rushed to the site in search of trapped survivors.

The quake struck a high-altitude area in the prefecture of Haixi in Qinghai at a depth of 10 km at 5:06 p.m. Beijing time on Tuesday, the China Earthquake Networks Centre said.

Initial checks showed transport, communication, water and power lines near the epicenter were operating normally, local newspaper Qinghai Daily said late on Tuesday.

Study: Global Conflicts Reached 80-Year High in '25

The number of armed conflicts worldwide reached its highest level since World War II last year, while conflict-related deaths climbed to their deadliest levels in more than three decades, according to a [new study](#) by researchers at Sweden's Uppsala University.

Researchers with the Uppsala Conflict Data Program, widely regarded as one of the world's leading trackers of armed violence, recorded 65 active conflicts last year, according to [KPBS](#).

The study found that direct conflicts between states doubled from the previous year to eight, the highest number since the organization began collecting data in 1946.

Massive 7.8 magnitude Philippines earthquake kills 32 and sparks terrifying tsunami

A massive 7.8 earthquake struck Mindanao in the southern Philippines leaving at 32 people dead and a terrifying tsunami.

The tremor also injured more than 200 others mostly in damaged buildings before sending a 1-meter (3-foot) tsunami into nearby coasts. The [quake](#) struck around 11:38 p.m. UTC Sunday, prompting the Pacific Tsunami Warning Center to issue [the warning for several countries](#) across the western Pacific. According to the PTWC, hazardous tsunami waves are possible and could affect parts of the Philippines, Indonesia, Palau, Yap, Taiwan, and Papua New Guinea within the next 3 hours.

According to the agency, the earliest projected arrivals are in coastal areas near the earthquake zone in the southern Philippines and eastern Indonesia, shortly after midnight UTC. Reports say that Davao, the largest city in the Philippines, could see the [first wave as early as 12:08 a.m.](#)

Earthquake cluster rattles West Coast near mega-tsunami danger zone

Three earthquakes rattled the U.S. West Coast on Wednesday, serving as another reminder that one of North America's most dangerous seismic zones lies just offshore.

The strongest of the trio struck off the southern Oregon coast, where the [U.S. Geological Survey reported a magnitude-5.7 earthquake approximately 100 miles west of Pistol River](#). The quake occurred at a depth of roughly 10 kilometers (6 miles) within the offshore Blanco Fracture Zone, a geologically active area where several tectonic plates interact. According to the USGS and the National Tsunami Warning Center, no tsunami threat was generated by the event.

The Oregon quake was accompanied by two additional earthquakes elsewhere along the West Coast on the same day. While none caused significant damage or injuries, the cluster attracted attention because of its proximity to one of the most closely watched seismic regions in North America, let alone the entire world.

Magnitude 6.2 earthquake shakes southern Italy

A strong earthquake tremor was felt across much of southern Italy shortly after midnight on 2 June.

The National Institute of Geophysics and Volcanology (INGV) recorded a magnitude 6.2 earthquake with its epicentre out at sea off Calabria's Tyrrhenian coast, near Belmonte Calabro, in the province of Cosenza. The quake struck at a depth of 250 kilometres.

The tremor was strongly felt along the Tyrrhenian coast, but no damage has been reported so far. The earthquake was also felt in Naples and the Vesuvius area, as well as in several parts of Calabria, Basilicata, Puglia and Sicily.

A magnitude 5.4 earthquake struck the Tongan Trench on June 3, 2026, shaking the seafloor roughly 180 kilometers northeast of Neiafu, the main town in Tonga's Vava'u island group. According to the [U.S. Geological Survey's real-time earthquake feed](#), the quake ranked among the strongest seismic events recorded anywhere in the South Pacific over the preceding 24 hours.

A magnitude 4.5 earthquake rattled the coast near Manokwari, a city of roughly 190,000 on the Bird's Head Peninsula in Indonesia's Papua region, during the last week of May 2026. According to the [USGS event page for this earthquake](#), the quake struck at a depth of approximately 10 kilometers at 03:42 UTC, placing the rupture squarely in the upper crust and concentrating energy close to the surface. That shallow origin likely produced sharp, distinct shaking for residents closest to the epicenter. No reports of significant damage or injuries have surfaced, but the event adds to a busy stretch of seismic activity along the Pacific Ring of Fire that has kept communities across the western Pacific on edge

Putin Says US Blocked 'Secret' Plutonium Deal With Iran

MOSCOW — Russian President Vladimir Putin said Saturday that the United States, Israel, and Iran had agreed to transfer enriched nuclear material from Iran to Russia, but that the arrangement ultimately collapsed after Washington reversed its position and demanded the material be sent only to the United States. Speaking during a lengthy post-Victory Day press conference at the Kremlin following military commemorations in Moscow, Putin described the earlier negotiations as a missed opportunity to reduce tensions in the Persian Gulf and revive confidence in diplomacy surrounding Iran's nuclear program. Addressing questions about the current standoff between Iran and the United States, Putin revealed details of the recent talks on the plutonium.

China's Commerce Ministry Blocks US Sanctions Against 5 Refineries

China's Ministry of Commerce said on Saturday it had issued an injunction to block U.S. sanctions imposed on five Chinese refiners accused of buying Iranian oil, according to state news agency Xinhua.

The ministry named the five as Hengli Petrochemical (Dalian) Refinery, and so called 'teapot' refineries Shandong Jincheng Petrochemical Group, Hebei Xinhai Chemical Group, Shouguang Luqing Petrochemical and Shandong Shengxing Chemical.

In April, the U.S. Treasury imposed sanctions on Hengli Petrochemical, accusing it of buying billions of dollars in Iranian oil, in an escalation of Washington's long-running effort to curb Tehran's oil revenue.

It struck at about 1:17 AM, the USGS said.

The earthquake probably caused light to moderate shaking, according to the USGS.

Warning 8.0-magnitude mega-earthquake could hit Japan

Japan issued a special advisory on Monday warning of an increased risk of earthquakes at magnitude 8.0 or stronger, after a powerful jolt rattled the country's north and prompted a tsunami warning.

The Japan Meteorological Agency said in a statement that 'the likelihood of a new, huge [earthquake](#) occurring is relatively higher than during normal times'. The warning for the northern region came a few hours after a 7.7-magnitude earthquake struck the area, shaking large buildings in the capital Tokyo, hundreds of miles from the epicentre.

The quake, which was initially estimated at magnitude 7.4 before being revised to 7.5 and again to 7.7, hit at 4.53pm (7.53am UK time) in Pacific waters off northern Iwate prefecture.

There were no immediate reports of serious injuries or significant damage, Chief Cabinet Secretary Minoru Kihara told a news conference.

Super Typhoon Sinlaku Pounds Remote US Islands in Pacific Ocean With Ferocious Winds

A super typhoon with ferocious winds and relentless rains was battering a group of remote U.S. islands in the Pacific Ocean, forcing residents to seek shelter from flying tree limbs and collapsed buildings.

The center of the Super Typhoon Sinlaku pounded the Northern Mariana Islands early Wednesday local time, the National Weather Service said.

It's the strongest tropical typhoon on Earth so far this year and was packing sustained winds of up to 150 mph (240 kph) that were likely to bring widespread power outages to the islands, home to roughly 50,000 people.

Two earthquakes happened Sunday on opposite sides of NC golf course, USGS says

Golfers had a legitimate excuse for missing strokes on Easter when two earthquakes rattled opposite sides of the [Holly Ridge Golf Links](#) southeast of Archdale, North Carolina.

The first happened just east of the 18-hole course around [2:15 p.m.](#) and the second was just west of it, about [30 minutes later](#), the U.S. Geological Survey reports.

Both were 2.3 magnitude, which is below the threshold for damage, but strong enough for some people to feel.

Witnesses have reported feeling both earthquakes in communities as far away as Randleman (64 miles away) and High Point (80 miles away), the USGS says. Holly Ridge Golf Links was open on Easter, but it's not clear if any golfers felt the earth move.

Geologists say the earthquakes were centered from a half mile deep to 3.5 miles deep.

According to the reports, from residents of the Haifa area, Akko (Acre), Nahariya, and Upper and West Galilee communities, the ground shook for several seconds, causing walls to shake and furniture to move.

According to the Euro-Mediterranean Seismological Centre (EMSC), the earthquake measured 4.5 magnitude, and its epicenter was adjacent to

southern Lebanon, between Tyre and Sidon, not far from the border with Israel.

The quake's depth is estimated at between 10 and 14 kilometers.
